Pre-Course Qualification Requirements:

- **Post-Secondary education:** At least seven (7) years of work experience in the oil palm sector OR ten (10) years in other relevant field (e.g. social, environment, occupational health and safety, and quality) OR five (5) years auditing experience in relevant accredited management systems (e.g. social, environment, occupational health and safety, and quality)
- **Tertiary education:** At least five (5) years of work experience in the oil palm sector OR seven (7) years in other relevant field (e.g. social, environment, occupational health and safety, and quality) OR five (5) years auditing experience in relevant accredited management systems (e.g. social, environment, occupational health and safety, and quality)
- Necessary prior knowledge of PDCA cycle, basic elements of management system, concept of MSPO 2.0, relevant national and local laws, and MSPO requirements
- Attended Awareness / Introduction of MS 2530:2022 Training
- Pass the Preliminary Test (not less than 70%)

DESCRIPTION
